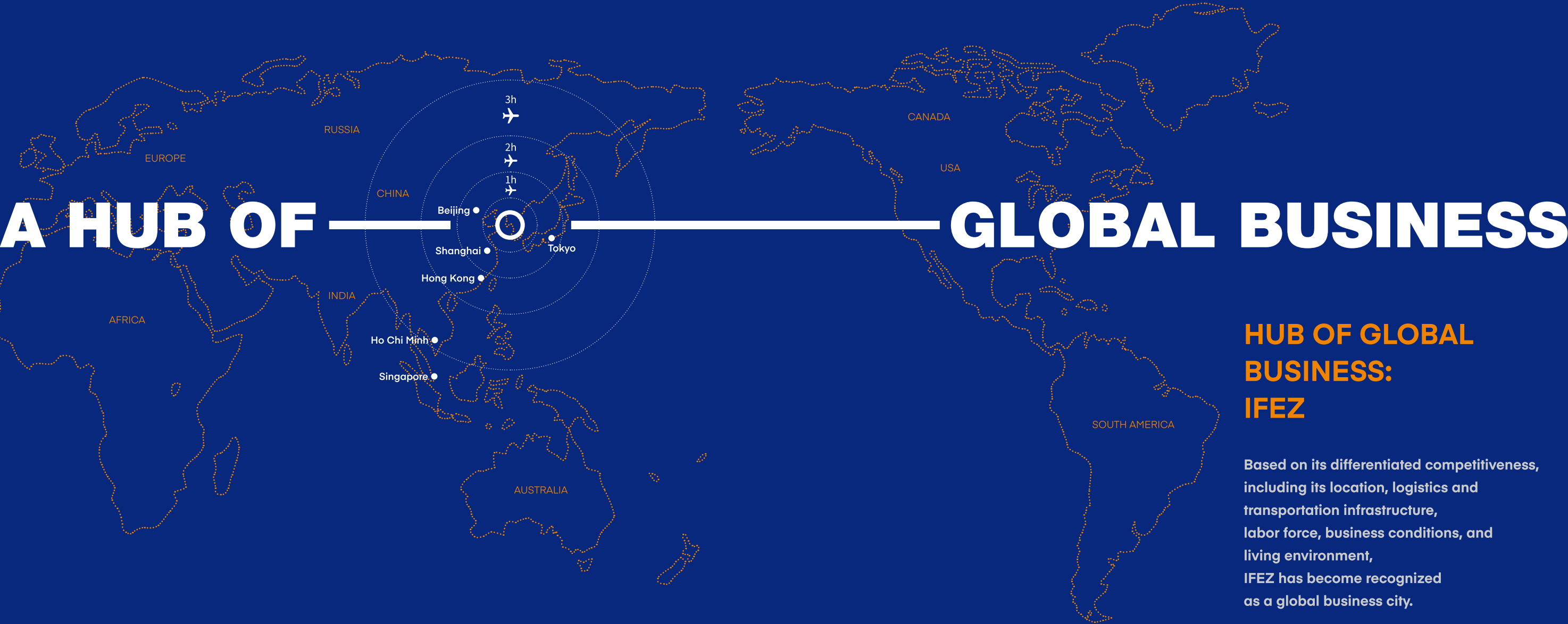

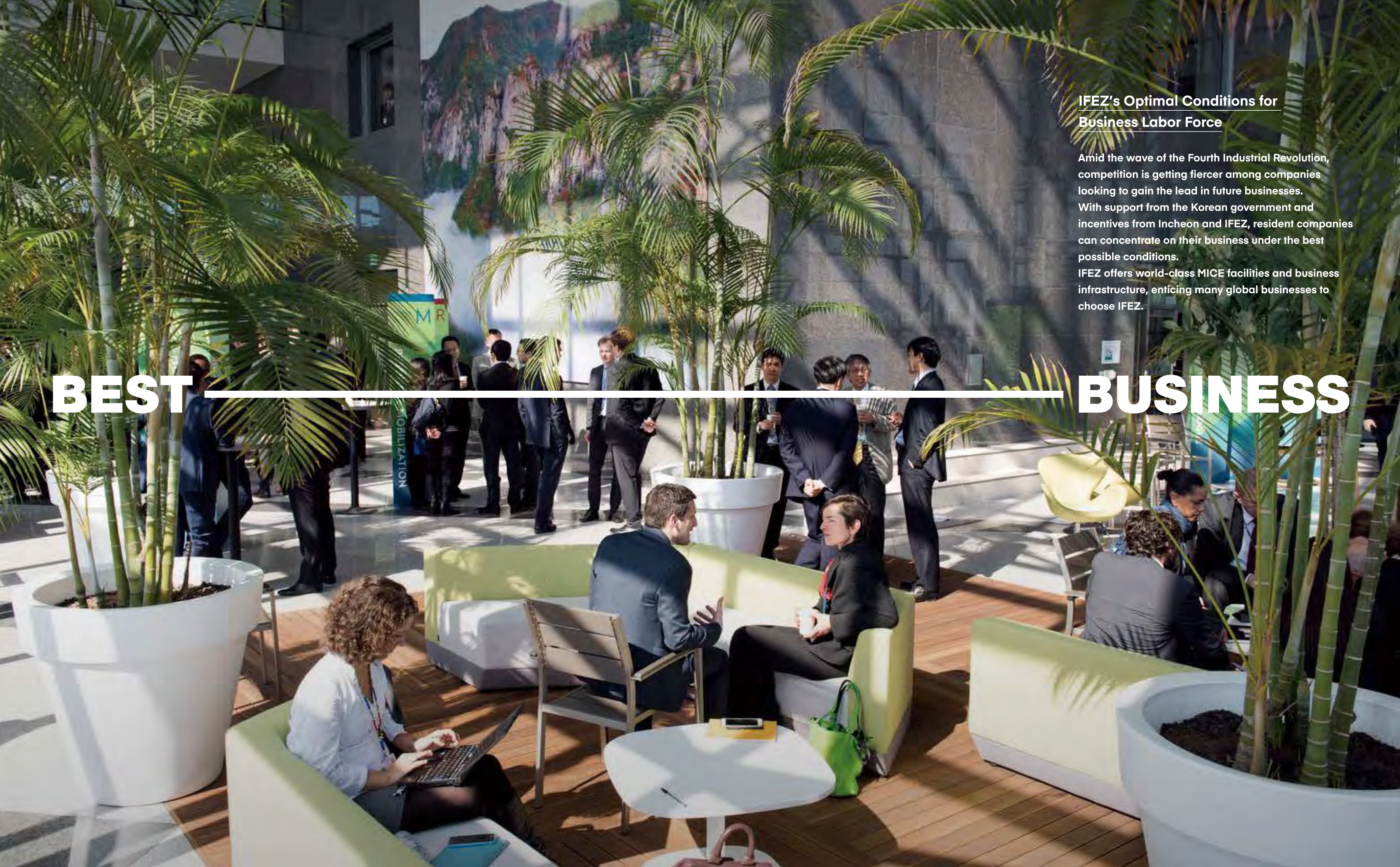

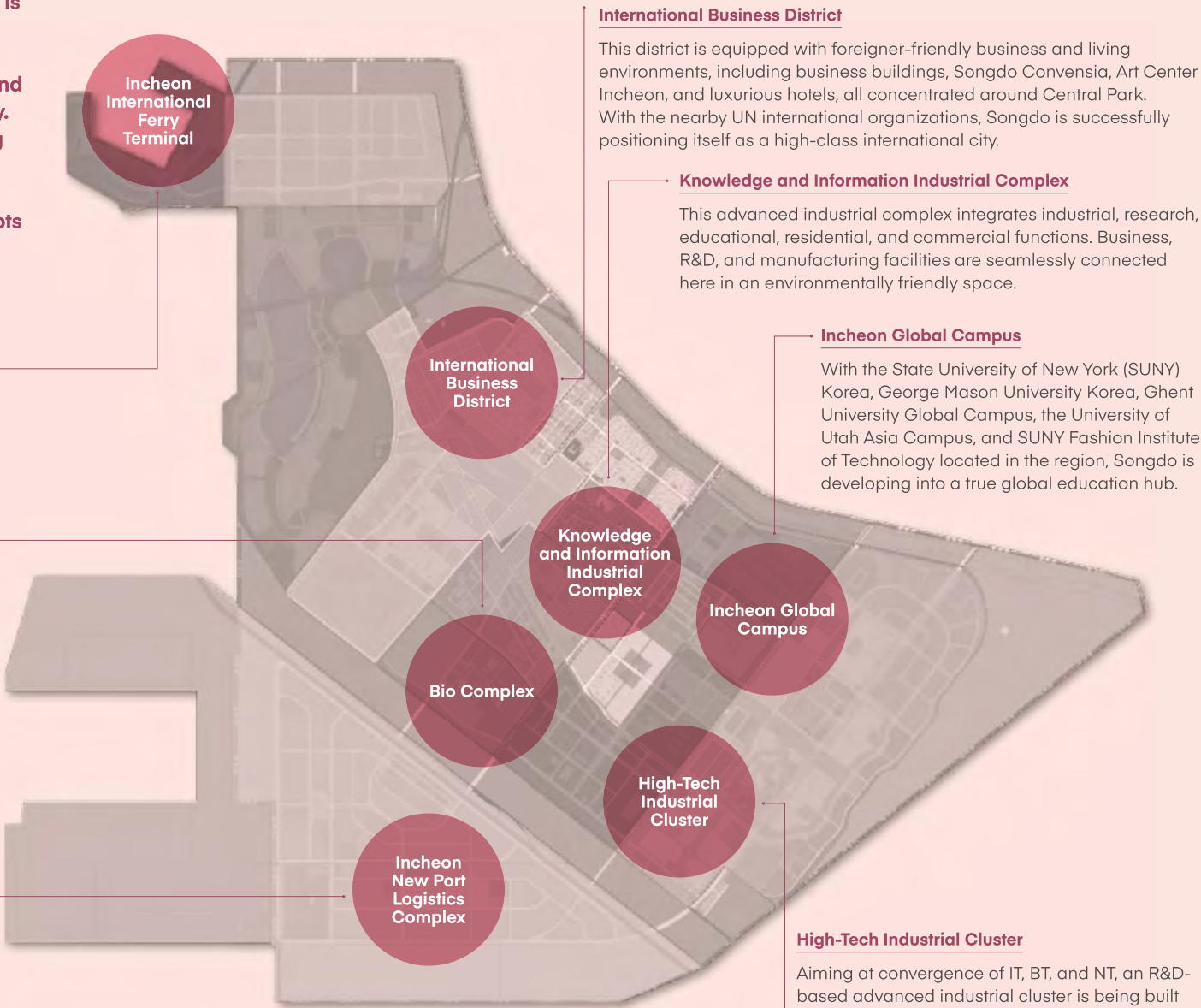

Bio Complex

This complex is specialized for world-class ordered medicines and regenerative medicines and is focusing on medical tourism, medical instruments, and manufacturing and R&D for biomedicine.

Incheon New Port Logistics Complex

Incheon New Port is a logistics complex with a maximum 12,000 TEU berthing capacity. It processes more than 60% of Incheon Port's total distribution quantity.

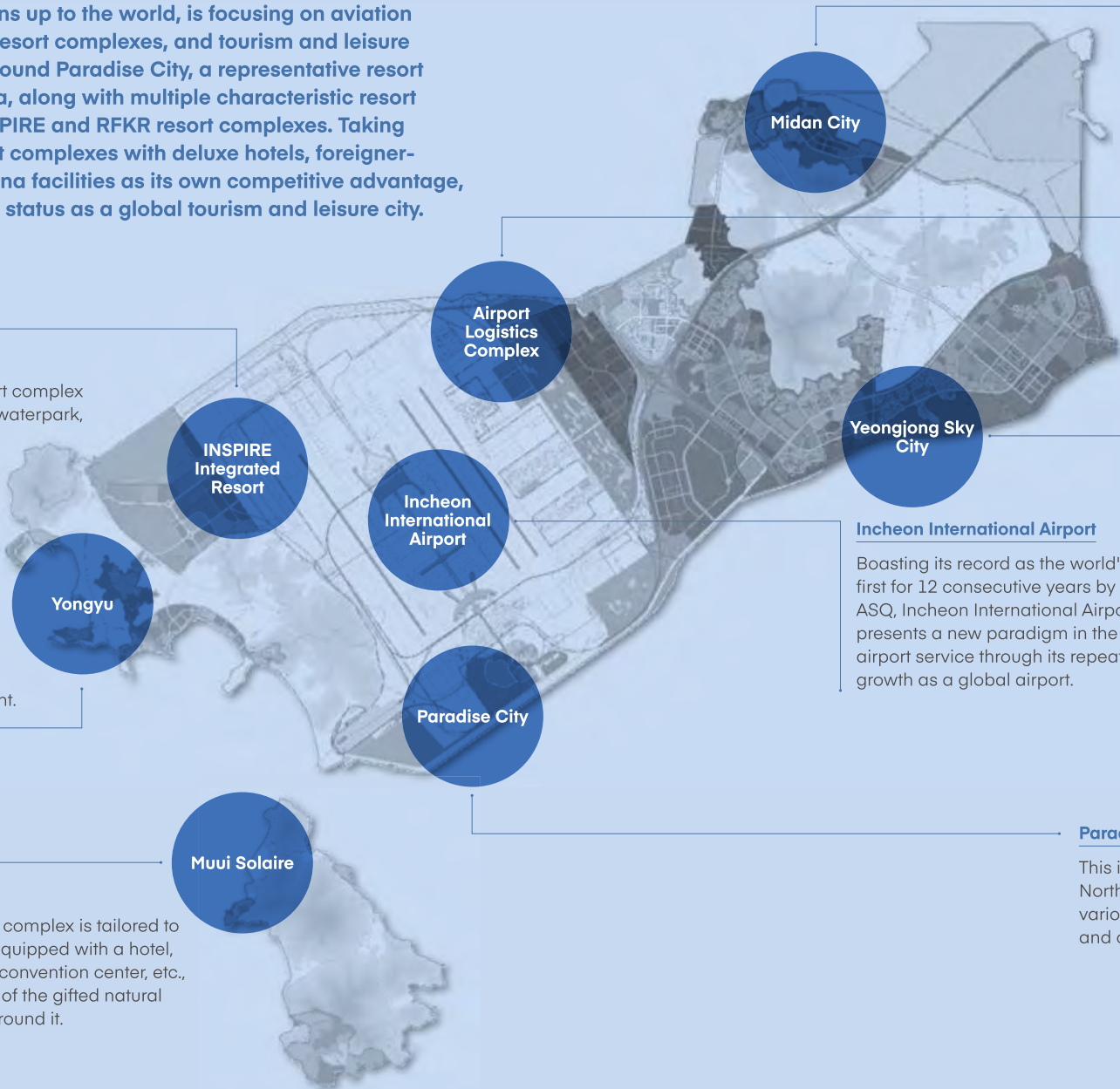
INSPIRE is being built as a resort complex offering a hotel, theater, indoor waterpark, and foreigner-exclusive casino.

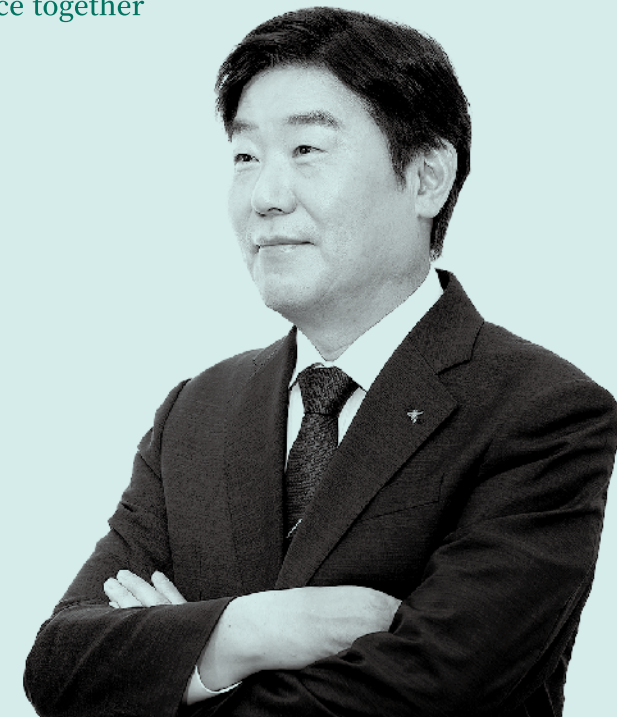

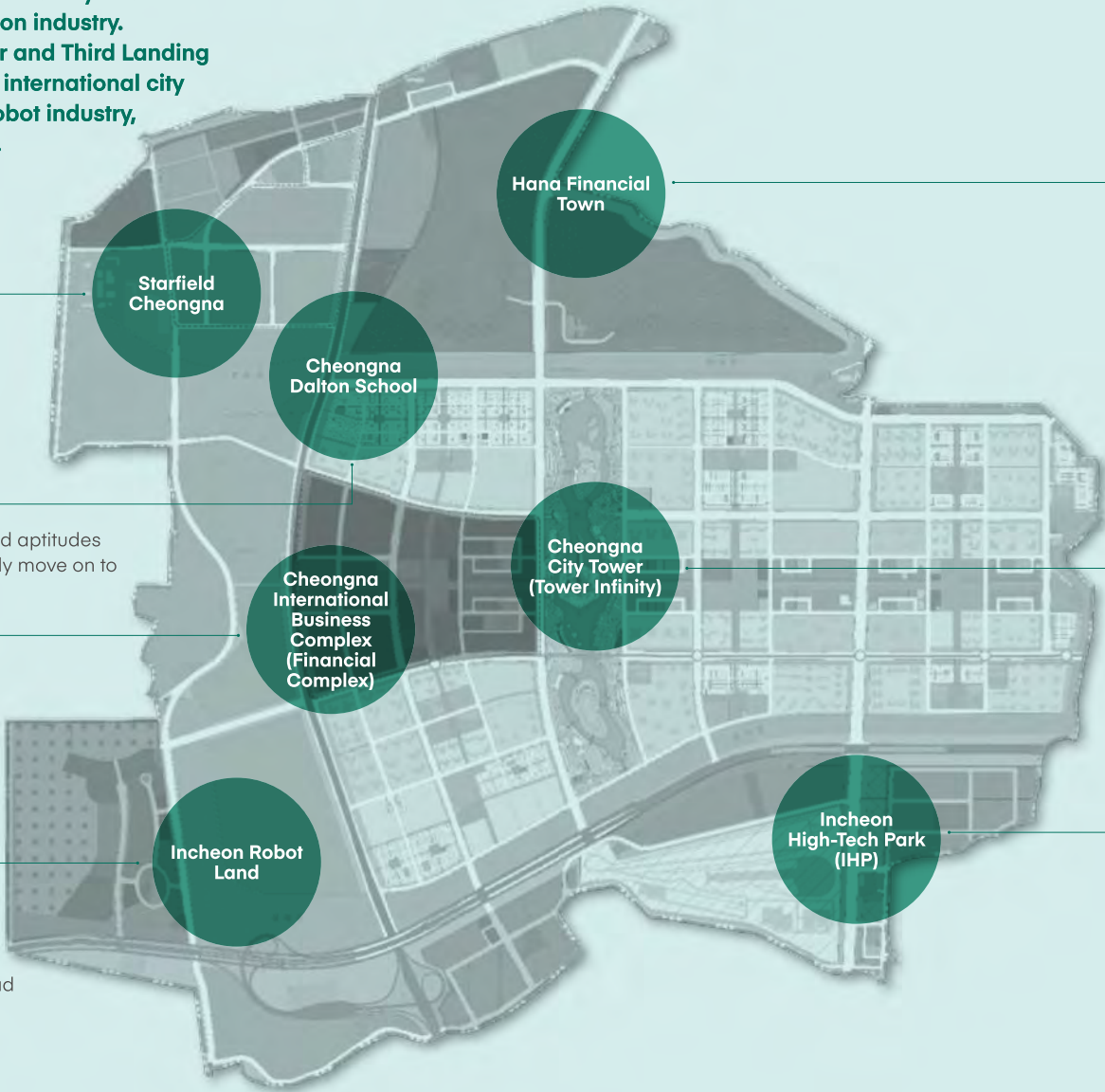

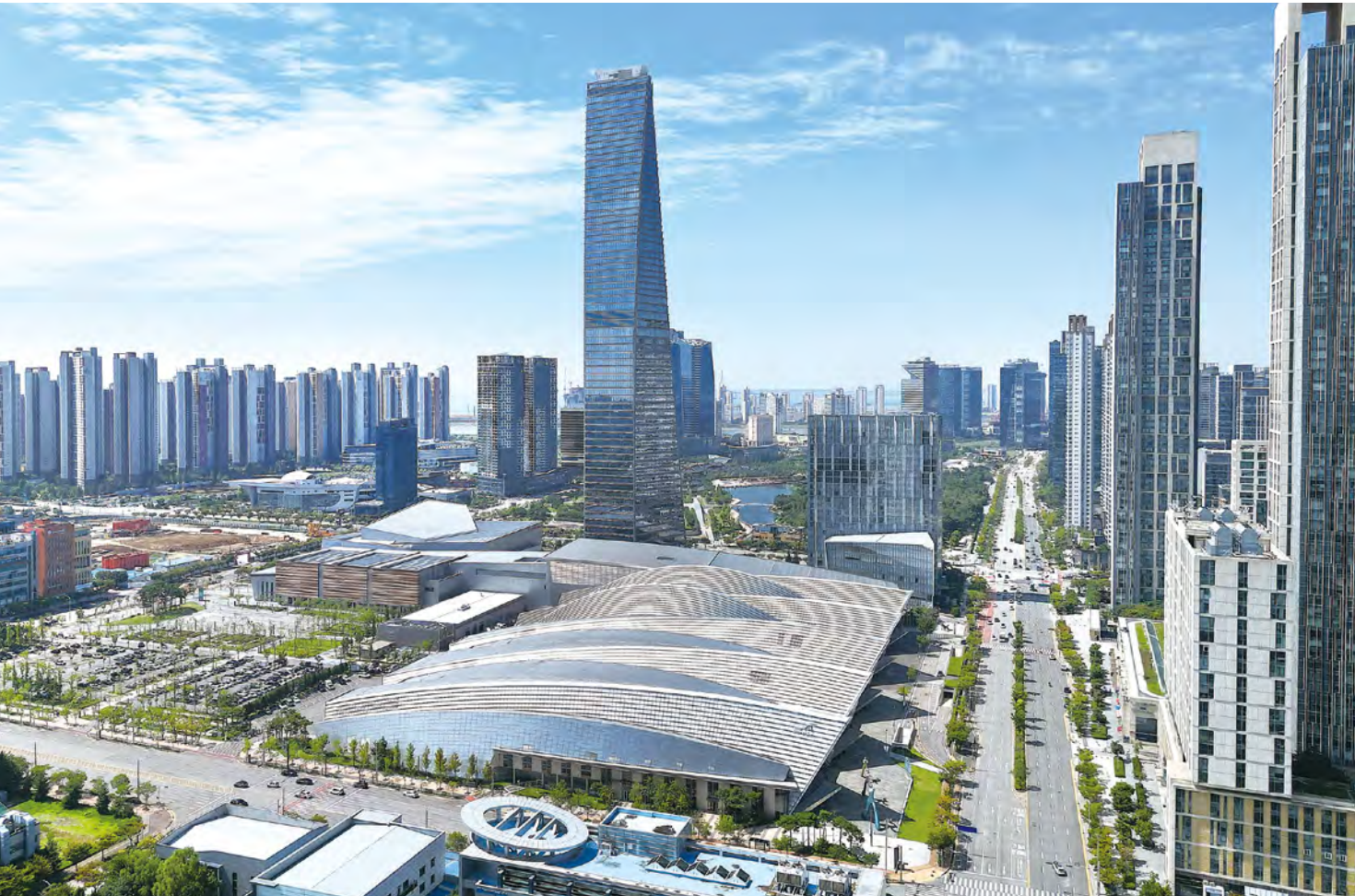

Global Business City Recognized by International Organizations

Including the executive office of the Green Climate Fund (GCF), the equivalent of the World Bank for the environment field, there are a total of 15 UN and international organizations located in IFEZ. Additionally, 206 global companies and roughly 3,481 companies are located in IFEZ, securing its status as a global business city.

Base City for Smart MICE

Songdo Convensia and its neighboring area, where state-of-the-art IT infrastructure, smart systems, and green areas harmoniously coexist, were designated as Korea's first ever international conference complex. In link with the resort complexes in Yeongjong, IFEZ is emerging as a base city for smart MICE to represent the Northeast Asian region.

International Financial Cluster

Hana Financial Group is set to complete Hana Financial Town by 2025, which has been a long-term construction project for the past 10 years, from its integrated data center to the global human resources development center and global headquarters in Cheongna.

The bio industry is the future industry emerging alongside the IT and semiconductor industries, and it is a field where global businesses are currently engaging in fierce competition. In IFEZ, about 90 industrial, academic, and research institutions, including Korea’s “Big 3” bio companies, comprise a bio cluster and are creating synergy. With this boost, IFEZ is preparing for yet another step toward the future.

World-Best Bio Cluster

The Big 3 bio companies in Korea – Samsung Biologics, Celltrion, and SK Bioscience – along with global raw and subsidiary materials companies, including Merck, Saint-Gobain, and Sartorius, joined the cluster, and K-Bio Lab Hub and the Bio Processing Human Resources Nurturing Center are planned to be built, pushing the region further toward becoming a global bio industrial cluster for bio companies, support facilities, and educational institutions to be positioned in harmony.

World-Largest Biomedicine Manufacturing Capacity

Songdo is equipped with 880,000-liter biomedicine manufacturing facilities, securing the world’s largest manufacturing capacity for a single city. Furthermore, it accounts for 46.3% of the total Korean medicine exports for the past five years, leading overseas exports in terms of Korean medicinal products.

Based on the seamless connection and network among biomedicine, medical, healthcare, R&D, manufacturing, and services, IFEZ has created a value chain and is maximizing its synergy effects.

IFEZ Is Accelerating Growth for Advanced Industries by Forming a Converged and Integrated Industrial Ecosystem

The Fourth Industrial Revolution is accelerating the technical evolution of global companies. Companies located in IFEZ and spanning various fields, including advanced manufacturing, semiconductors, automobile parts, aviation, robots, and drones, are forming a converged and integrated industrial ecosystem that brings together leading technologies and differentiated competitiveness to foster continued growth. IFEZ now sits at center stage for future pioneer companies.

Advanced Manufacturing Industry

In the Songdo advanced industrial cluster, many world-class IT-based advanced manufacturing companies have settled in and are conducting business activities. With the recent moving-in of global companies in the metal-processing equipment and three-dimensional metal-printing fields, the advanced industrial cluster is expanding further.

Automobile and Parts Industry

Centered around Songdo and Cheongna IHP, companies, including GM, Hyundai Mobis, Mando Brose, HL Klemove, Kyungshin, and Daedong HI-LEX, comprise a future automotive industrial cluster.

Semiconductor Industry

Global semiconductor post-processing companies, including Amkor Technology and STATS ChipPAC, along with semiconductor material- and equipment-related companies, including Henkel, A1 Engineering, and TOK Advanced Material, have gathered in IFEZ to form the mecca of the Korean semiconductor industry.

Aviation Industry

Thanks to the locational advantage of being so close to Incheon International Airport, world-class aviation manufacturing and service companies, including the Yeongjong Air Flight Training Center and Aircraft Engine Maintenance Center and Songdo Huneed Technologies, have taken up residence in IFEZ. In addition, R&D activities by the Institute for Aerospace Industry-Academia Collaboration on urban air mobility (UAM), maintenance, repair, and overhaul (MRO), etc., are leading the future aviation industry.

Robot and Drone Industry

Cheongna is the center for nurturing companies in advanced industries, such as robots and drones. Robot Land, a large-scale robot-industry nurturing complex, is under construction, and support facilities, such as the Robot Demonstration Support Center, are helping with the development of the robot industry. For development of the drone industry, projects with the Drone Certification Center are actively underway.

The State University of New York (SUNY) Korea, George Mason University Korea, Ghent University Global Campus, the University of Utah Asia Campus, and SUNY Fashion Institute of Technology share a united campus and provide the same curriculums as their original campuses abroad.

Excellent Korean Universities

Yonsei University built its International Campus as an extension of its main campus, and Incheon University built a new campus to become a base university for the Incheon region. They are currently nurturing excellent local talents and growing together with companies and institutions in IFEZ.

International Schools Fostering Global Talents

Chadwick International School in Songdo and Cheongna Dalton School are foreigner-focused educational institutions that operate a variety of education programs for children of local and foreign residents and contribute to fostering future global talents.

IFEZ Is Driving the Shift of the Medical Paradigm away from Treatment and towards Prevention and Tourism

The plan for medical services in IFEZ is different. IFEZ has made its differentiated medical system a focal point in its quest for improved health of citizens and better quality of life. Starting with the construction of a state-of-the-art medical system, including Songdo Severance Hospital and Cheongna Medical Complex Town, it is expanding the border towards medical tourism where leisure and medical care are combined.

Songdo Severance Hospital
Songdo Severance Hospital is to be built within the International Campus of Yonsei University and will be equipped with 800 beds. It will serve as a research-specialized hospital that focuses on bio convergence research. Based on the Korea-best medical services and infrastructure of the Severance Hospital of Yonsei University, Songdo Severance Hospital will provide specialized and differentiated services.

Cheongna Medical Complex Town
This is a large-scale project to build an 800-bed general hospital, medical- and bio-related industrial, academic, and research institutes, business facilities, medical tourism facilities, and convenience facilities in Cheongna. To secure enough competitiveness to attract patients seeking intensive care within Korea and in the world at large, a future-oriented quaternary hospital with the best possible medical staff and instruments will be constructed.

Base City for Medical Tourism
The demand for medical services is expanding its scope beyond treatment to medical tourism that embraces prevention, management, and rest. IFEZ is grasping its geographical advantage of being close to Incheon International Airport and a number of resort complexes as its competitive edge and is planning differentiated medical systems for Songdo, Yeongjong, and Cheongna while considering their regional characteristics.

IFEZ is pursuing its goal of being a green city where people and nature coexist in harmony. The green areas around its downtown core provide a refreshing environment for daily living. 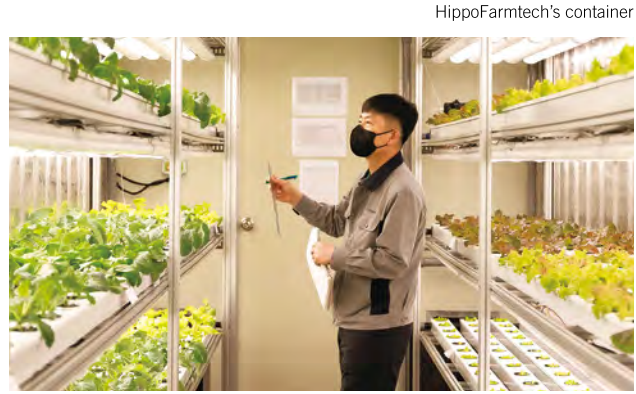

Amid the reorganization of the economic order, driven by the Fourth Industrial Revolution, IFEZ is concentrating on forming an innovative ecosystem for startups through open innovation and led by Incheon Startup Park. Additionally, it has been recognized for its best practices as a smart city by adding IT infrastructure to the urban infrastructures of Songdo, Yeongjong, and Cheongna. Based on the innovative technologies of local startups and its own smart city competitiveness, IFEZ is leading innovative growth for the future.

Smart City Completing the Future City

IFEZ was designed as a greenfield smart city from the stage of urban planning. It added IT infrastructure onto the urban landscapes of Songdo, Yeongjong, and Cheongna and developed a number of its own smart city solutions, thereby securing technological competitiveness. Using the technologies of the Fourth Industrial Revolution, IFEZ has continuously innovated the urban space and is presenting a sustainable and new model for a future city.

Incheon Startup Park Leading Future Innovation

Incheon Startup Park is the largest startup-support space in Korea and aims to emerge as the Korean Silicon Valley. It is the very first model in Korea for nurturing startups by combining private experience and capabilities and public support. Incheon Startup Park provides extensive support for startups in the AI, smart city, and bio convergence fields, which are the key technologies of the Fourth Industrial Revolution, for their demonstration, investment, and entrance into the global market, aiming at establishing a startup ecosystem for future unicorn companies.

City for Demonstrating Innovative Technologies

IFEZ provides diverse resources and operates citizen-participating programs for urban testing of innovative ideas and technologies held by the private sector and startups. The space, facilities, equipment, data, network, and administrative support for demonstration are provided for quick commercialization of innovative technologies. 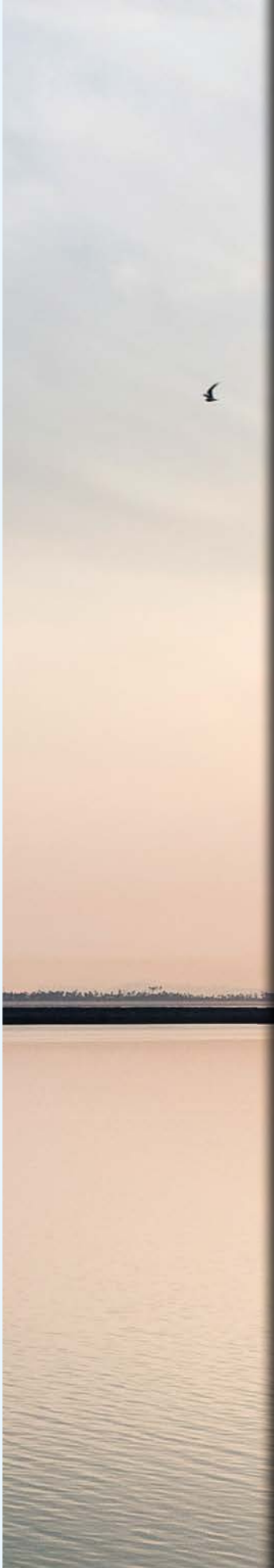
