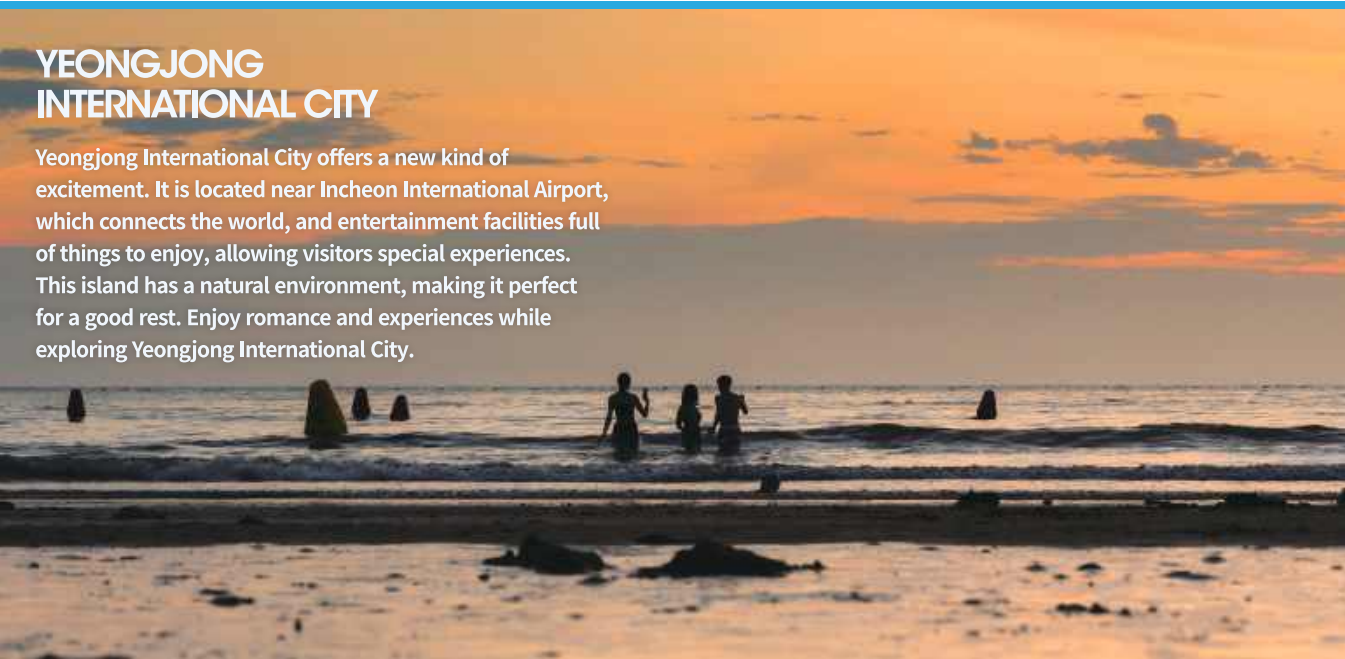

Cheongna International City

Cheongna Lake Park | B2

In addition, various performances are held at Flower Music Island, which has an outdoor stage.
