

Have you ever wondered what happens inside Incheon Metropolitan City Waterworks, or how we clean water to the highest quality standard?

At the Waterworks Institute of Incheon Metropolitan City Government, we offer the opportunity to visit a potable water treatment plant and a water laboratory.

Tours are free of charge for schools and community groups within Incheon. In return for the visit, we ask that you provide us with feedback, that you use water wisely and help us look after your tap water.

Pre-booking is essential. Please be aware that site visits are very limited and we may not be able to provide this service at the time you require it.

The site tours are run by our education coordinator who will discuss each group's needs prior to confirming the booking.



Criteria for lab tour & site visits:

- **Visitors must be foreign residents in Incheon.**
- A minimum visitor number is 5 and a maximum of 20 (negotiable).
- Approved protective lab clothing and goggles will be provided for all visitors.
- A pre-visit by the group leader is a mandatory requirement for any group that has not visited the site before.
- **English will be the main language during site visiting,** however Chinese and Japanese interpreters will be accompanied.

Contents of lab tour & site visits:

- Oral and video presentation (0.5 hr): The history of potable water treatment,
Introduction of Incheon Waterworks.
- Lab tour (1.0 hr): Laboratory tour of Incheon Waterworks Institute.
Introduction of analytical equipments & water analysis.
- Site visit (1.5 hr): Each facility of Bupyeong Water Treatment Plant.
