## SONGDO INT'L CITY

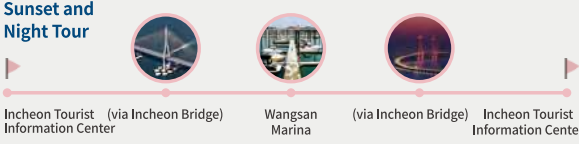
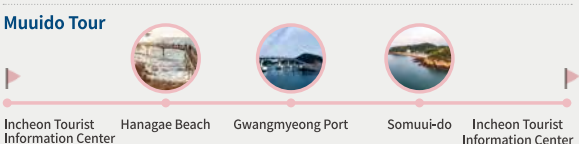

From Geojampo Beach, one can see a small island off the shore. This island is known as "Maedorang" but is also called "Shark Island" because of its resemblance to a shark's fin. Many photographers visit this spot to photograph the rising sun as it emerges from behind Maedorang.
