Songdo Central Park

Songdo Central Park is the representative landmark of Songdo International City. Songdo Central Park, a park with green nature spread out between a forest of high-rise buildings, is Korea's first marine park and is great for a leisurely walk. You can enjoy leisure activities in the artificial waterway. You can use canoes and boats at East Boat House, and you can experience a water taxi at West Boat House. When night falls, the city lights and the park's night lights come together, making the park even more splendid.

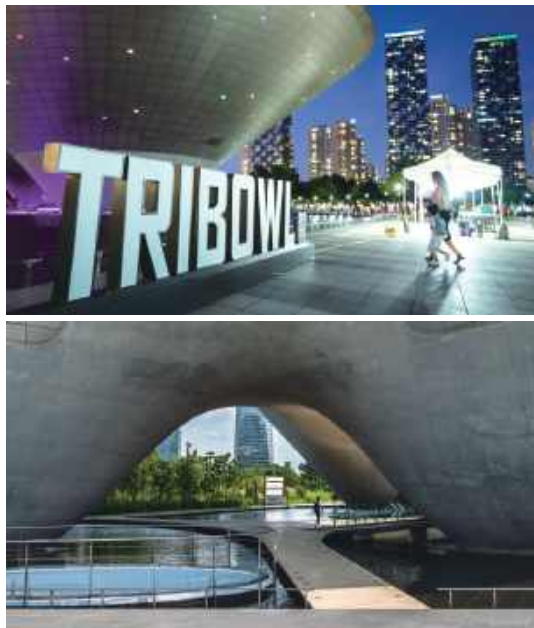

The gently crashing waves calm the mind. It is perfect for feeling the simple and stylish atmosphere of a rural fishing village.

Masian Beach

This beach is famous for its endless tidal flats and sandy beaches that unfold when the tide goes out. The beautiful beach that unfolds like a panorama is the longest in Yongyu-do Island, with a total length of 2.5km. The beach is surrounded by pine trees, making it a great place for a leisurely walk.

Geojampo Beach

The pine forest that surrounds the beach like a folding screen creates a unique atmosphere in harmony with the Geojampo Pier. The small island, Maedorang, which can be seen from the coast, is also called 'Shark Island' because it resembles a shark's fin, and many photographers come to capture the sun rising behind Maedorang.

Muuido Island

An increasing number of visitors are going to Muuido, an island located south of Incheon Airport, after the opening of Muui Bridge. Tourist attractions include Hana-gae Beach, which boasts fine sand and wide tidal flats, and the marine tourism trail, where you can walk over the sea and admire the coastal cliffs. Also, Horyong-goksan Mountain, the highest mountain here, is perfect for trekking.

Somuuido Island

It is an island with a simple fishing village scenery, where you can enjoy a good rest, romance, and trekking around the island. In the middle of the course, there is the Somuuido Storium, which has a unique exterior resembling a conch, to learn more about the place.

Silmido Island

Silmido, an uninhabited island attached to Muuido Island, became known to the world when the movie of the same name was released. It was a place where the Korean Central Intelligence Agency secretly trained the 684th Unit for North Korean operations in the 1960s. Twice a day, the tide goes out, revealing a wide sandy plain connected to the island, which can be walked to from Silmi Beach.

Sindo, Sido, and Modo Islands

Sindo, Sido, and Modo Islands are called the 'Three-Brother Islands' because they are crowded together. The three islands are connected by bridges, making them popular as a day trip destination. The slope of the trails is slow, so you can enjoy an eccentric trip using an electric bike. A bridge connecting Yeongjong International City and these islands is scheduled to be completed in 2025.

Cheongna Lake Park

This is a large-scale waterside park that is a symbol of Cheongna International City, the city of water. The circular path that connects the two areas is filled with different attractions, such as the eco zone, traditional zone, leisure zone, and art zone. During the day, you can enjoy leisurely walks and bicycles, and at night, you can enjoy a different kind of pleasure with the musical fountain that is operated for a limited time. Various performances are held at Flower Music Island, which has an outdoor stage.

Gyeongin Ara Waterway

It is the first and only canal in Korea that connects the Hangang River and the sea off Incheon. The 18km waterway from the Ara Incheon Passenger Terminal in front of Yeongjong Bridge to the Gimpo Terminal has a walking path and a bicycle path, making it excellent for riding. If you do not want to miss the various charms of the Gyeongin Ara Waterway, such as the observatory and waterfall, we recommend taking a cruise.

National Institute of Biological Resources

It is the only exhibition hall specializing in indigenous organisms in Korea, where you can see over 1,600 species and 6,000 biological resources. In the three exhibition halls, you can observe specimens of living organisms that live in various parts of the Korean Peninsula as their habitats, and the Gotjawal Ecological Museum, which recreates the Jeju Island's subtropical forest ecosystem, offers a unique attraction.

Open Port Area

Open Port Area is at the center of Incheon's modern history. It maintains a history of 140 years since Jemulpo Port opened in 1883. Looking around the historical and cultural spaces that have accumulated traces of time, such as the Incheon Art Platform, Incheon Open Port Museum, and China Town, you will feel like you are walking through the past.

Incheon Art Platform

A space filled with red brick buildings. Incheon Art Platform is a complex cultural and artistic space created by remodeling a building that was a warehouse at Incheon Port at the time of its opening. The buildings that have been preserved over time and the diverse works of artists catch the eyes of travelers. Inside, there are art spaces such as workshops, exhibition halls, and studios, where various exhibitions, performances, and events are held.

Is this Korea or China? With its exotic scenery, China Town is a small China in Incheon. The red color seen everywhere in the buildings represents the Chinese culture, art, and life that has formed here. It also has a variety of food that lets you experience the taste of China, such as white jjajangmyeon, lamb skewers, oven dumplings, balloon bread, and candied fruits.

Songwol-dong Fairy Tale Village

Songwol-dong Fairy Tale Village is where you can meet the main characters of fairy tale books you read as a child. You will meet numerous characters as you walk along 11 fairy tale theme roads, including Dorothy Road, Red Riding Hood Road, and Traditional Fairy Tale Road. In addition to murals, there are various sculptures, such as the Little Mermaid's shell chair and the giant castle where Snow White lives, allowing you to enjoy the fairy tale experience more vividly.

Jjajangmyeon Museum

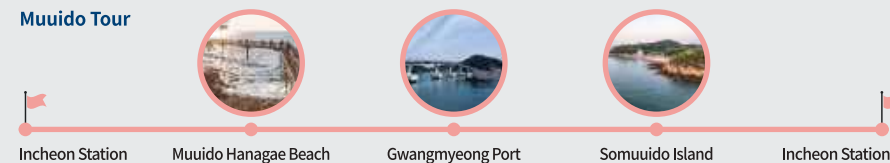

It is also simple to purchase and use the card. Read the following to enjoy the benefits.**

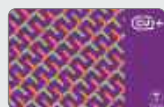
If you use a transportation card, you can receive a transfer discount for subways and buses. However, you must transfer within 30 minutes after getting off. (1-hour transfer discount between 9 p.m. and 7 a.m.)

How to Use

Tag the transportation card on the card reader when getting on and off (two times in total)

Note

No transfer discount is applied on the same route



T-MONEY

It can be used on subways, taxis, airport buses, and metropolitan buses. It can be used at major convenience stores, subways, and unmanned parcel storage lockers, and you can charge it with money at convenience stores.
